<u>M/Weitz, 2nd/Murray: That the District continue its membership in the New York State</u> <u>Association of Fire Districts and the Association of Fire Districts of the Capital District for the</u> <u>year 2014. Passed 4-0.</u>

<u>M/ Murray, 2nd/ Weitz: That the Treasurer be covered by Insurance Bond to the current level of coverage for 2014. Passed 4-0.</u>

M/ Murray, 2nd/ Weitz: That TD Bank be designated as the District's official bank for 2014. Passed 4-0.

M/ Murray, 2nd/ Weitz: To re-approve the following Fire District Policies and Procedures: Purchasing Policy, Purchasing Procedure, Exercise Room Policy, Media Policy, Chief Vehicle Policy, Unlawful Workplace Harassment Policy, Alcohol & Drug Policy, Credit Card Policy, <u>Code of Ethics, Travel Expense Policy, Military Leave Policy, Operation of District Vehicles</u> <u>Policy, Career Division Appointment Procedure and Installation and/or Inspection Dinner</u> <u>Policy, Investment Policy, Promotion Procedure and Members Moving out of the District policy.</u> <u>Passed 4-0.</u>

<u>M/ Murray, 2nd/ Nappi: To allow Chief Lingenfelter and Chief Dietrich to purchase Personal</u> <u>Protective Equipment (PPE) for 2014 as per the 2014 Budget. Passed 4-0.</u>
